



One Day: Design for Safety (DfS) Appreciation Training Course

Background

The Design for Safety (DfS) course is a mandatory training program in Singapore aimed at equipping professionals in the built environment sector with the knowledge and skills to incorporate safety considerations into the design and planning stages of construction projects. This course is aligned with the requirements of the *Workplace Safety and Health (Design for Safety) Regulations 2015*, which mandate that DfS professionals be appointed for projects with a contract value of S\$10 million and above.

Participants will gain a comprehensive understanding of DfS principles, regulatory obligations, risk management techniques, and collaborative approaches for hazard elimination and risk reduction. The course emphasizes the integration of safety through all project phases, fostering collaboration between developers, designers, and contractors to prevent foreseeable risks to any person involved in construction, use, or maintenance of the structure.

Remarks:

WSH Council has published the "Guidelines on DfS in Buildings and Structures" back in 2008 (first issued) and first revision in 2011. "WSH Guidelines-Design for Safety" published on 1st Aug 2016. New Version of the same was Published in August 2022.



Purpose of Attending Design for Safety (DfS) Appreciation Training Course

It is to equip designers, contractors & WSH personnel with the basic DfS competency knowledge under the WSH (Design for Safety) Regulations, i.e. Regulation 5, Developer's duties in respect of designers and contractors.(1) The Developer of a project may appoint a person as (a) a designer b) a contractor for a structure required in the project only if the Developer reasonably practicable believe that the person is competent to perform the duties of a designer under these Regulations and other regulation made under section 65 of the Act.

Remarks:

Common misconception:

- 1) *DfS review only start when the DfS Professional is appointed or on-board?*
- 2) *Contractor do not require to attend any DfS training course?*
- 3) *DfS is only for Main contract sum of \$10 million and above?*
- 4) *DfS is not applicable for the "Advance works" such as demolition and services diversion and termination works?*
- 5) *Designer is not required to identify "design risks" and put up control measures?*
- 6) *Contractor is not required to identify "design risks" and put up control measures?*
- 7) *Appointed Specialist designer (QP/ PE) is not required to identify "design risks" and put up control measures?*
- 8) *No site works should be done until Main Contractor is appointed?*
- 9) *Complying with Legal requirements is considered "reasonably practicable"?*
- 10) *Is it mandated to implement all the SS/ COP/Guidelines under the WSH (Approved Code of Practices) Notification?*
- 11) *Who decision to make changes to the "design plan"? Developer, Designer, Contractor, DfS Professional?*
